Young Cosette – Female, stage age 7, under 140cm

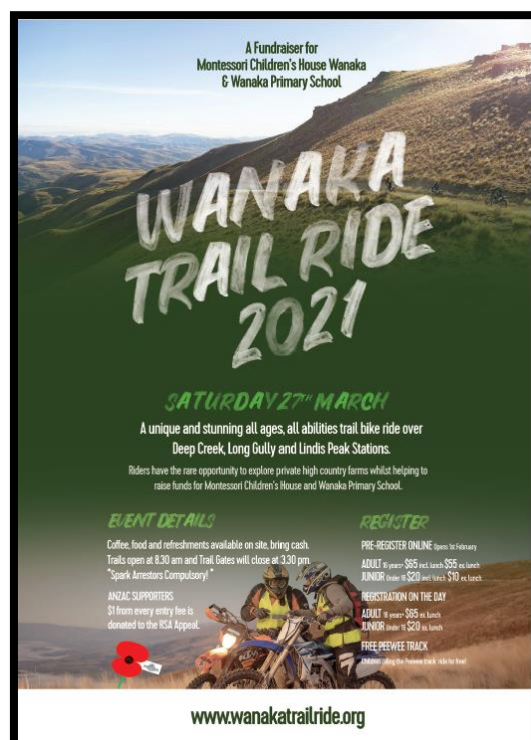
Young Eponine – Female stage age 7, under 140cm
